## Magic Pillowcase

You'll be done before you can say abracadabra!

## What you need:

- 27" x 42" of "main" fabric
- 10" x 42" of "cuff" fabric
- 2½" x 42" of "accent" fabric
- Sewing tools: scissors, pins, needle and thread/sewing machine

## What to do:

- 1. With right sides facing out, press the accent piece in half lengthwise.
- 2. Lay the cuff flat, right side up. (If there is a directional print, it should be upside down from your perspective.) Lay the accent piece on top, matching up the raw edges.
- 3. Lay the main piece on top of these, right side down. Pin in place.
- 4. Starting at the bottom, roll the main fabric towards the top edge where everything is pinned. Stop once you can see an inch or two of the cuff fabric.
- 5. Fold the cuff fabric over the roll you have made, line up the raw edges to where the other pins are, then pin this in place also.
- 6. Sew a straight stitch using a ½" seam allowance.
- 7. Carefully pull the fabric out of the tube and press. Trim or square up ends as needed.
- 8. Fold the whole thing in half, wrong sides together. Be sure to match up the seam lines between the cuff and accent.
- 9. Straight stitch along the side and bottom using a 1/4" seam allowance.
- 10. Trim the corners to reduce bulk (don't cut the stitch line!), turn inside out, and press the seam flat.
- 11. Repeat step 9, but use a ½" seam allowance this time. You may want it a bit larger if you have selvedge that may show on the outside of the finished project: use your best judgement here.
- 12. Turn right sides out, insert a pillow, and have magical dreams!
